208. WITHDRAWAL/REMOVAL FROM SCHOOL	
<p>1. Purpose SC 1326, 1327 Title 22 Sec. 11.13, 12.1</p>	<p>The Joint Operating Committee affirms that while law requires school attendance of a student only between the ages of eight (8) and seventeen (17), it is in the best interests of both students and the community that students complete the educational program that will equip them with skills and increase their chances for a successful life beyond school.</p>
<p>2. Authority</p> <p>Pol. 233</p>	<p>The Joint Operating Committee directs that whenever a student wishes to withdraw, efforts should be made to determine the underlying reason for such action. The resources of the center should be utilized to assist the student in pursuing career goals.</p> <p>Center personnel cannot reject students or refuse to admit students to class at any time during their membership in center courses. The only procedure for removing a student from the center is by expulsion. This will occur only after a disciplinary problem has developed and the expulsion procedure established by the Joint Operating Committee has been followed.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>The Administrative Director or designee shall develop administrative regulations to govern a student's withdrawal from the center.</p> <p>If a participating high school principal chooses to withdraw a student from the center during the course of the year, s/he may do so at his/her own discretion. This decision may be based upon recommendation from the Administrative Director. The center will make such a recommendation only after the instructor and the Director have documented their own effort to do everything reasonably possible to assist the student in adjusting to his/her program, learning acceptable behavior patterns, and developing a reasonable interest in his/her subject area.</p>
