223. USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES	
1. Purpose	The Joint Operating Committee regards the use of motor vehicles for travel to and from school by students as an assumption of responsibility by parents/guardians and students.
2. Authority	<p>Driving is a privilege, and students must have a specific need for driving. The Joint Operating Committee shall permit the use of motor vehicles by students in accordance with the center's rules, provided that such students are licensed drivers, have followed established procedures and obtained the required parking tag, and have been granted permission by the building administrator to drive a motor vehicle on school grounds.</p> <p>Students shall not be permitted to transport other students to or from the center.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee prohibits the use of motorcycles on school property.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee shall not be responsible for motor vehicles that are lost, stolen, or damaged.</p> <p>Driving privileges may be revoked if Joint Operating Committee policy and established rules and regulations are not followed.</p>
3. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The building administrator or designee shall develop rules and regulations for requesting permission to drive to the center; granting parking tags; and the parking of motor vehicles.
