	<b>232. STUDENT INVOLVEMENT IN DECISION-MAKING</b>
1. Purpose	The Joint Operating Committee believes that students should participate in the governance of school activities at levels appropriate to their ages and competencies because students are a valuable resource whose contributions can aid and benefit the programs of the center.
2. Authority	<p>The Joint Operating Committee directs that students be invited to participate in activities appropriate to their maturity and competency, leading to administrative decision-making.</p> <p>Suggestions for improvement of the school may be offered by any student, provided they are of a constructive nature and contribute toward the realization of the center's educational goals.</p>
3. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The Administrative Director or designee shall develop rules to implement this policy which:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Provide for submission, consideration, and response to constructive student suggestions.</li><li>2. Designate the manner by which students shall be selected for participation in center matters.</li><li>3.
