Therefore, the Joint Operating Committee encourages the administration to seek the benefits and savings that may accrue through joint agreements with other political subdivisions for the purchase of supplies, equipment or services.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee authorizes the Administrative Director to negotiate appropriate cooperative purchase agreements with other political subdivisions, in accordance with law and Joint Operating Committee policy.</p> <p>Cooperative purchases require an agreement approved by the Joint Operating Committee and the participating contracting body(s) which may specify:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Categories of equipment or supplies to be purchased.</li> <li>2. Manner of advertising for bids and awarding contracts.</li> <li>3. Method of payment by each participating party.</li> <li>4.
